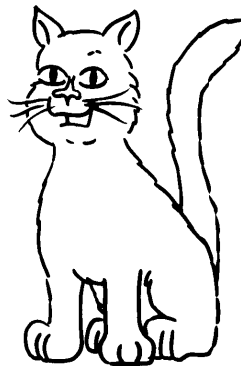
Be sure to visit me often and spend time with me. But even if I'm not feeling social right away, I will come around when I feel secure.
