

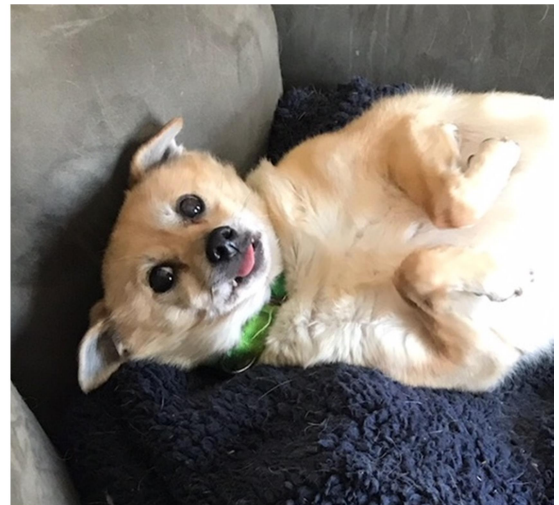


## Tails of Life Saving
