

GUIDELINES FOR LOOKING FOR FLASH



**FLASH WAS DRAGGING A BLUE
LEASH AT LAST SIGHTING -
LOOK FOR THE BLUE LEASH!**

***MOST IMPORTANT –
DO NOT CHASE***

**We want Flash to stay in whatever
area he is in and chasing him may
drive him out of the area and into
traffic/danger.**

STAY QUIET! We want to **LISTEN** for sounds in the brush, foliage, wooded areas. If you hear rustling, whimpering, anything try to check it out and make a note of the location. The only sound you should be making is playing Jenny Mosman's voice clip on your phone every once in awhile.

If you spot Flash – do not move toward him, do not make any noise.

Instead, **stop, turn sideways or sit down, avoid eye contact, and become very boring and quiet.** If he comes closer, toss extremely smelly treats *away from yourself* rather than reaching toward him. **Immediately call Jenny Mo at (920) 896-3650.** Then take a photo and note the location. Do not move from the location until Jenny arrives.

If you see anything suspicious, like a small "nest" area, potential tracks, or anything that seems odd, take a photo, note the location and text both to Jenny Mo.
